What am I voting on?

You are voting to elect two members to KICA's Board of Directors. Three candidates are running for the board. The future of Kiawah ~~is~~ on ~~the~~ leadership, so please take the time to cast your vote.

How and when do I vote?

There are three ways to vote. You may cast your vote **online** (recommended) at vtnw.com/go/KICA, mail a signed **paper ballot**, or call **844-797-4575**. Voting opens on Jan. 7 and votes must be received by March 8. Once your vote is cast, it cannot be revoked.

Where can I find my voter registration number?

If you received your voting materials by email, your registration number can be found within the email from Vote Now. If you received your voting materials by mail, your voter registration number is printed in your materials.

Why is assigning the proxy to the board secretary important?

KICA must have 51% of the membership represented at the meeting to meet quorum. Even if you plan to attend the meeting, please assign the proxy to the board secretary to ensure quorum is met. Your vote in the board election is by ballot and not affected by the proxy assignment. No other business will be voted on at the meeting.
