A Quick Overview



What is the KICA Board?

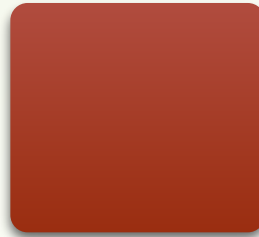
- ▶ According to the bylaws- “The board helps steer major policy decisions, establishes and drives both the association’s mission and vision, engages in planning, and hires the chief operating officer (COO)...”
- ▶ The Board is made up of six Property Owner Directors who are elected, and one Director appointed by the developer.
 - ▶ Board members are elected to three-year terms, beginning and ending with a March Annual meeting.
- ▶ Board members are volunteers.



What are the
key
responsibilities
of Board
members?



Develop, review and monitor KICA's long-range plans, such as budgets, investments, strategic and business plans.



Prepare for, attend and participate in board and committee meetings.



Exercise fiduciary duties consistent with South Carolina law



Serve the interests of KICA as a whole, rather than any special interest group or constituency.



What are the time commitments for Board member?

- ▶ Monthly meetings:
 - ▶ Public Board meetings are held every other month and typically last three to four hours.
 - ▶ Board workshops are held on the alternating months and usually last four to five hours.
- ▶ Board Committees, such as the Finance and Nominating Committees, require additional preparation and time commitment.
- ▶ There may be time periods of intense activity and additional meetings scheduled.
- ▶ Board members need to set aside 10 to 20 hours per month for Board service, with leadership positions requiring additional time.

Why should you consider Board service?

Share your leadership skills and individual talents with the community.



Give back to the community.



Represent the interests of your fellow property owners.



Be part of the process that ensures the look and feel of Kiawah for the future.



What are the steps involving in running for the KICA Board?

- ▶ Be a KICA member, and be able and willing to make the time commitment to participate if elected.
- ▶ Submit a completed application form (found on website) and associated material, including a biography to nominatingcmte@kica.us.
 - ▶ Information you submit, as well as a video interview, will be posted on the KICA web site.
- ▶ Application deadline is October 16, 2018.
- ▶ The Nominating Committee will contact each individual who submits an application for an interview.
