I currently serve on the Board of Directors for Bible Study Fellowship, International (BSF).



BSF offers in-depth Bible study classes for people of all ages and backgrounds, reaching more than 390,000 adults and 77,000 children in over 1,250 classes and 37 countries.

I have also served on the Board of Visitors for UNC Children's Hospital. UNC Children's is a top-tier academic medical center. It is a major referral center for children with complex conditions and consistently recognized by the U.S. News & World Report as one of "America's Best Children's Hospitals" on its annual list. The physicians at UNC Children's work hand-in-hand with community hospitals and pediatricians all across North Carolina, providing specialty care to more than 70,000 children from all 100 counties in North Carolina each year.

In addition, I've served on the Global Advisory Council for BSF and worked with the BSF Headquarters Training Team where I wrote materials and trained BSF leaders who hailed from around the world.

I spent 25+ years as a banking executive and over the course of my career led business operations, human resources, and learning and development teams. I have been recognized for my work in developing and implementing performance improvement initiatives among diverse work groups and have consulted with corporations in measuring the return-on-investment (ROI) of these types of initiatives. My work in this area has been featured in industry publications.

MY FOCUS

My life and the lives of my family have been enriched by the Kiawah community and experience. I know that communities like ours don't just happen. I am running for a seat on the KICA Board of Directors because I want to be a part of the effort required to enhance and maintain the allure of Kiawah for new and existing owners.
