## Charter - Governance Task Force

### KICA Strategic Plan

Preserving the Kiawah Experience for Future Generations. Creating Kiawah memories and experiences for the current membership is a primary responsibility of the association. Additionally, it's critically important to plan for the future to ensure Kiawah remains special.

- KICA will work cooperatively and collaboratively with the town, the developer and the resort for the benefit of association members.
- Ensure the accountability and enforcement of community standards and covenant compliance.

### Membership

The Chair of the Task Force shall be a current KICA Board member selected by the KICA Board, with the developer director, plus 3-5 members of the Community. The selected Task Force members should represent as many demographic facets as possible of KICA members.

### KICA Board/Task Force Interface

The Task Force shall report to the KICA Board.

### KICA Staff/Task Force Interface

KICA staff will assist in the information collection and dissemination function of the Task Force. The KICA COO will act as a liaison between the Task Force and KICA staff.



## Task Force Goals

- Task Force to review KICA Covenants & By-laws and make recommendations to the Board on possible revisions to these documents.
- Task Force to make recommendations on communications of potential Covenant and By-law changes to the membership.
- In order to assist the Task Force, they will be authorized to hire outside South Carolina counsel to assist in these efforts.
- The Chair of the Task Force will make a recommendation of counsel, to be approved by the KICA Board.
- The Task Force is initially authorized to spend up to \$25,000 on legal fees. Any fees beyond that amount will require subsequent Board approval
