POLICY RESOLUTION NUMBER P-93-2

SUBJECT: EXPENDITURE OF MUNICIPAL OR OTHER PUBLIC FUNDS BEHIND THE SECURITY GATE

WHEREAS, the security gates and other private features of Kiawah Island contribute to and preserve its unique character as a desirable place to reside; and

WHEREAS, the Kiawah Island Community Association, Inc. believes that the preservation of these private features is of the utmost priority to the Kiawah Island Community Association, Inc. and its members; and

WHEREAS, the expenditure of municipal or other public revenues "behind the security gate" may call into question the legal right of the Kiawah Island Community Association, Inc. and its members to maintain these important features;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it is the policy and express desire of the Kiawah Island Community Association, Inc. that the Town of Kiawah, or other interested persons or entities, refrain from the expenditure of municipal, state, federal, or other governmental revenues "behind" the main security gate or, if such revenues are to be spent, assure that the use of such revenues is done cautiously, prudently, and legally, without imperilling the rights of the Association and its members to maintain the security gate and other attributes of private control that are essential to the betterment and well-being of the property and lives of its members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contents of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor and Council members of the Town of Kiawah, for their information, and that this Resolution be preserved in the minutes of the Kiawah Island Community Association, Inc.
