Resolution of the KICA Board of Directors To Establish a Legal Committee of the Board

WHEREAS the Kiawah Island Community Association, Inc. (hereinafter "KICA") received a derivative lawsuit demand letter from KICA members Timothy Hazel, Perry Molinoff, Todd Boney & Larry Rutkowski, dated March 26, 2023 (hereinafter "the demand letter");

WHERAS the demand letter is specifically related to the master developer and the Architectural Review Board, and the Developer Director Amanda Mole is an employee of the master developer and Chair of the Architectural Review Board.

WHEREAS it is necessary for KICA to be able to discuss the demand letter and any resulting litigation with its legal counsel, protecting the privilege with the elected directors;

WHEREAS, the KICA Bylaws, under Article VIII, Section 1 authorizes the KICA Board of Directors to form a committee comprised of one or more Directors to act with the authority of the Board;

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2023, the KICA Board voted to establish a Legal Committee of the Board, related solely to the above-named matter. The vote was approved by a majority of directors (6-0-1).
